Single Stream Recycling

At TCNJ, all recyclables can be placed in the same container!

Acceptable paper, bottle, and canned items do not need to be separated.



Acceptable Items for Recycling at TCNJ

Paper

- Mixed Paper
 - Office and copy paper
 - Paper envelopes
 - Paper file folders
 - Colored paper
 - Standard junk mail
 - Food menus
 - Magazines
 - Phone books
- Newspaper
- Cardboard
 - Corrugated cardboard (must be broken down)



Bottles and Cans

- Plastic Bottles
 - 1-4 plastics
- Glass
 - Bottles
 - Jars
 - Food/beverage containers
- Metal Cans
 - Tin
 - Steel
 - Bi-metal
 - Aluminum

Common Unacceptable Items



- Plastics #5-7
- Paper Coffee Cups
- Textbooks
- Wax-coated Cardboard
- Tissues
- Paper Towels
- Paper Food Plates

CDs, DVDs, VHS

Batteries

Take to the BSC help desk



Cellphones and Ink Cartridges

Take to the Telecommunications office



How do I know what number plastic I have?

On the bottom or side of the bottle, you will see a number inside a triangle formed by three arrows, as shown.

Empty out bottles and cans before discarding them.

Don't place garbage inside of recyclable items (ex: don't place napkins inside of plastic coffee cups.)
